Every time we pray, we end with the same three words, "In Jesus Name." This prayer habit was inspired by Jesus' words in John 14:13 "I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son." While we know that Jesus' name is not a magic word, we also know it is important. Merely saying His name is not the same as praying in His name. Rather, really knowing God's name involves knowing who God is and what He is like in person. If we know His name, we know Him. Knowing God's name is what empowers us to trust Him. This Fall we will be learning about the various names and phrases used in the Bible to describe God, so we might know Him better, trust Him more and pray with confidence and power.


