



*Key Verse: "The LORD will fight for you; you need only to be still."

Week 1: June 6-12, 2021

Baby Moses

Exodus 1-2:10



Opening God's Word

Read Exodus 1-2:10 as a family.

Questions for Discussion:

- God kept His promise and blessed Abraham with many descendants (vs. 1:7). Joseph had been very helpful to the Pharaoh so he and his family were welcomed and safe in Egypt. But how are the Israelites being treated at this point in the Bible? (vs. 1:8-14)
- The Pharaoh wanted to hurt all the baby boys, but what did this baby's mother do? (vs. 2:2-4)
- Who found the baby? (vs. 2:5)
- What did the baby's sister do? (vs. 2:7-8)
- Who was going to be taking care of this baby for the Pharaoh's daughter? (vs. 2:9)
- Why would he be safe now? (vs. 2:10)
- What was the baby's name? (vs. 2:10)
- God protected Moses and put him in the palace for a purpose. We will be learning more about God's big plans for Moses over the next few weeks. Kids, ask your grown-up to share a time when they experienced God's protection.



Prayer

Take some time to pray as a family. Thank God for His protection and His perfect plans. Thank Him for always keeping His promises. Continue praying however you feel led.




Family Challenge




Make this Baby Moses Snack with a banana, fruit roll up, and cupcake liner.


A Baby by the River
